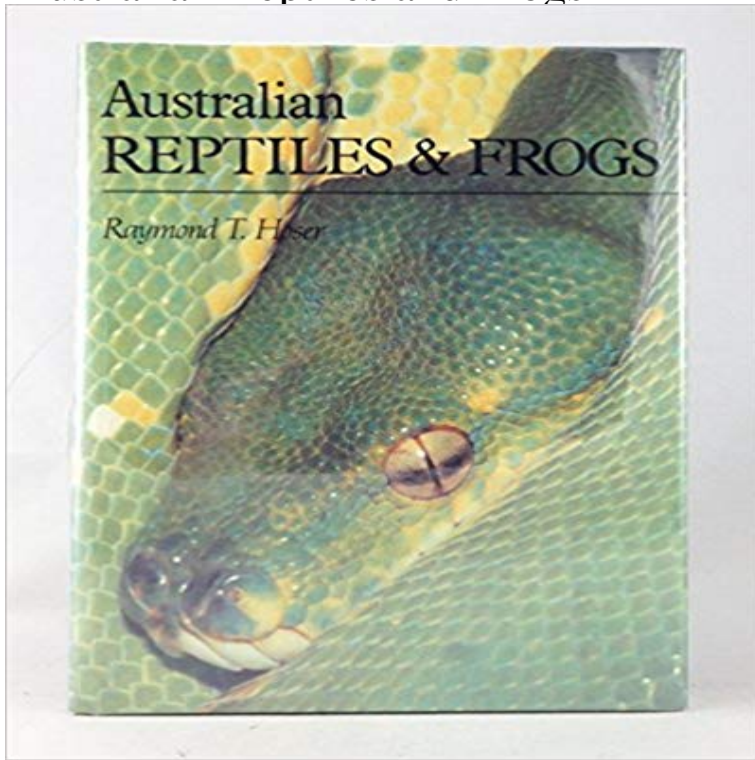


Australian Reptiles and Frogs
