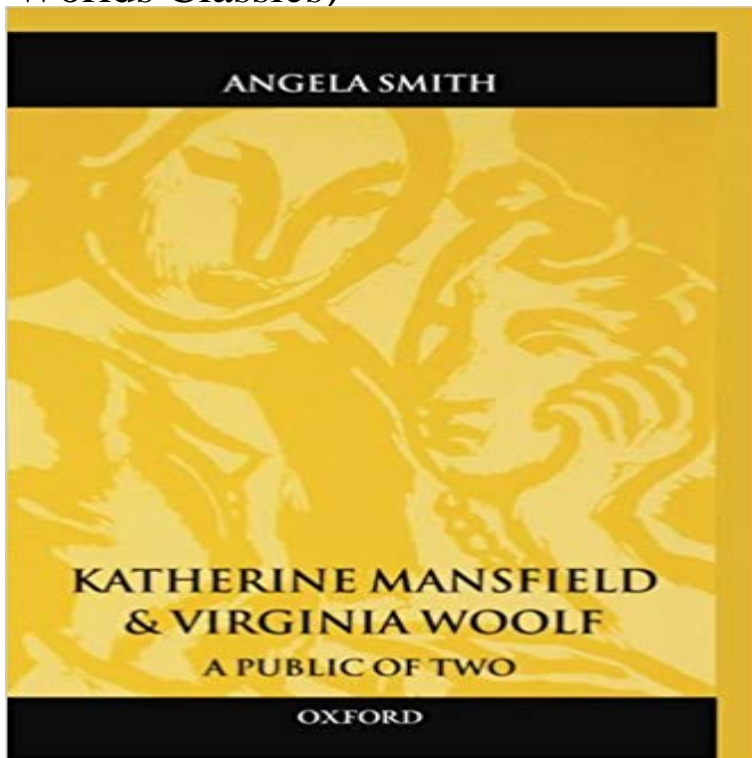


# Katherine Mansfield and Virginia Woolf: A Public of Two (Oxford Worlds Classics)
