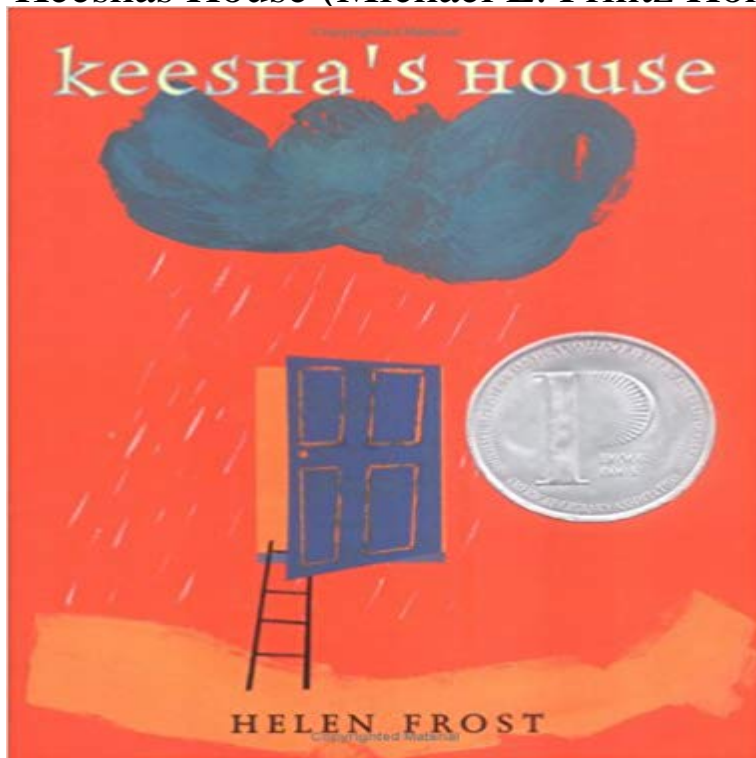


Keeshas House (Michael L. Printz Honor Book (Awards))
