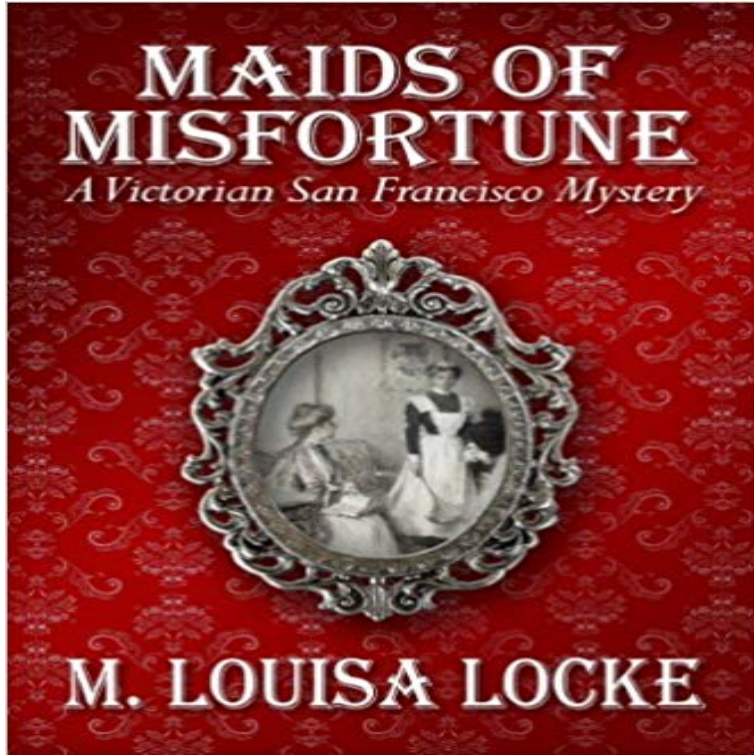


Maids of Misfortune: A Victorian San Francisco Mystery
