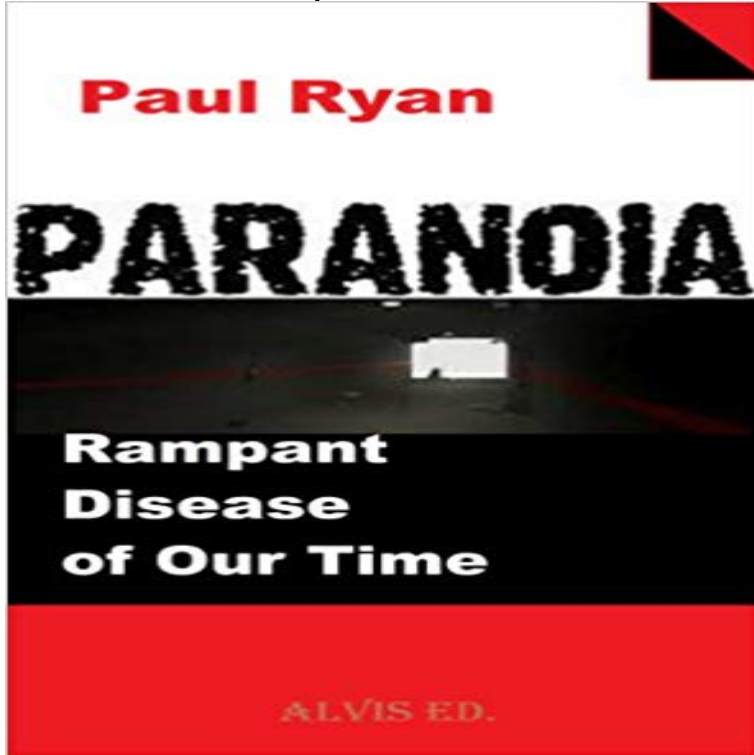


Paranoia - Rampant Disease of Our Time
