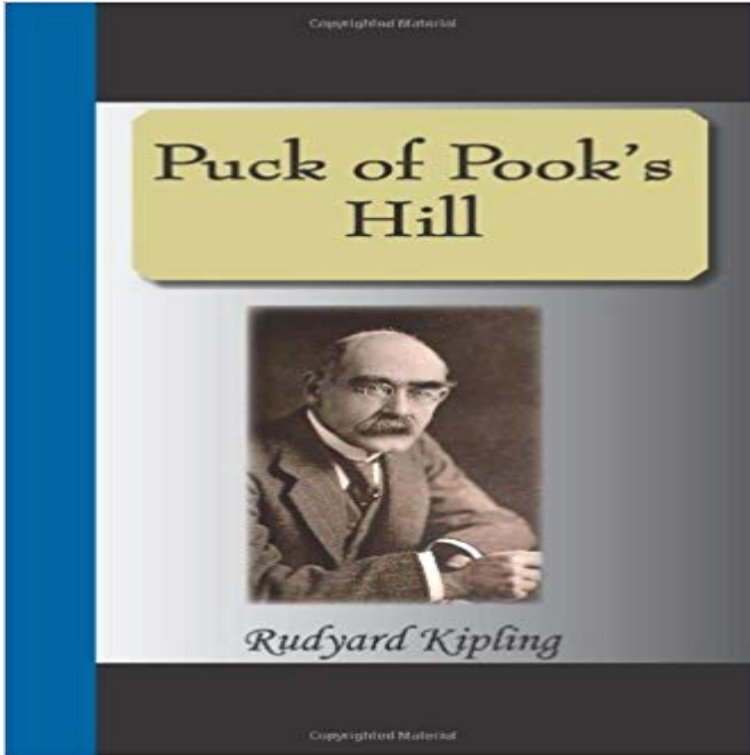


Puck of Pooks Hill
