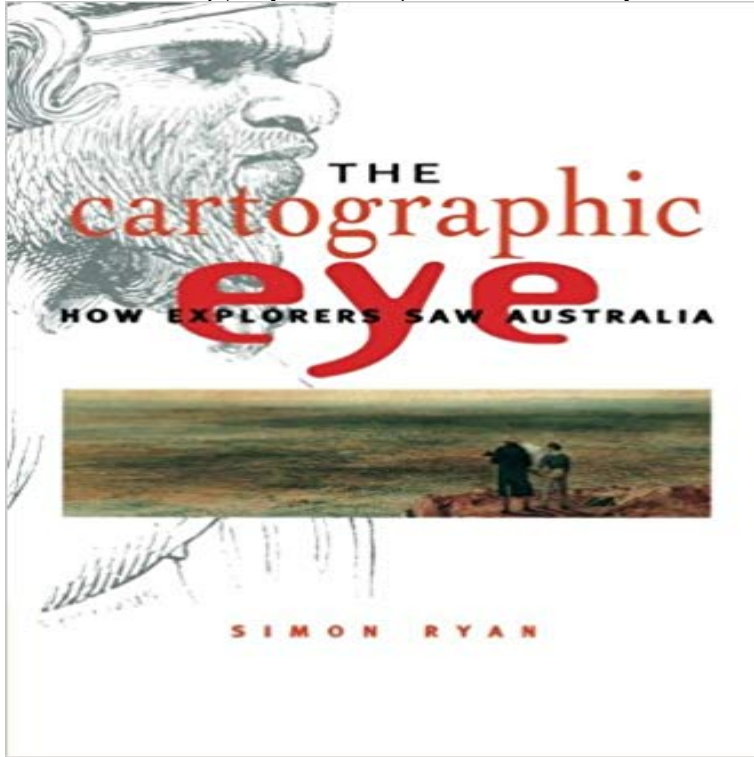


The Cartographic Eye: How Explorers Saw Australia
