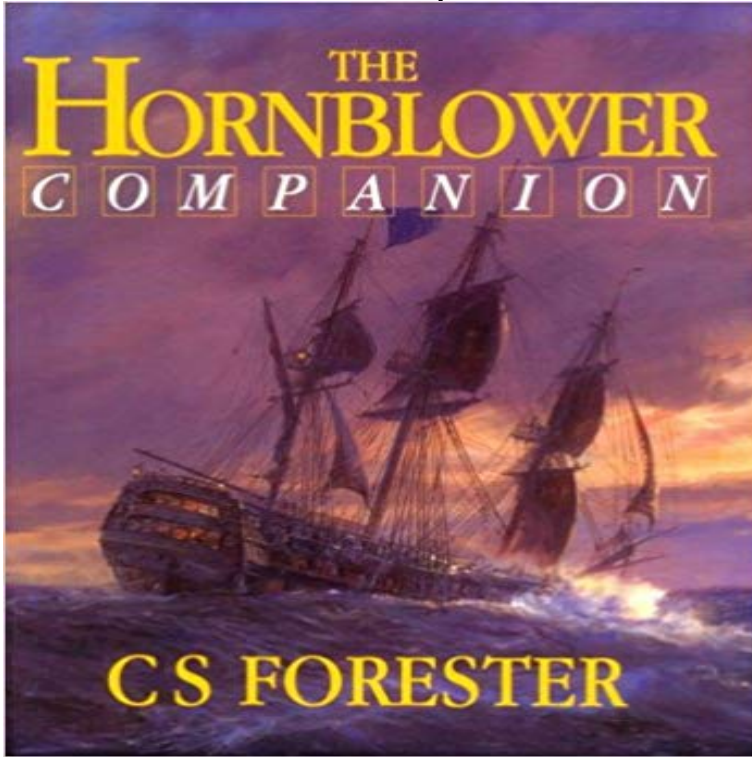


The Hornblower Companion
